EUROPEAN POOMSAE CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 10th European Poomsae Championships take place in Genoa, Italy from 20th to 22nd May. Angie Bailey will be representing the UK in the 1st Masters Female and 2nd Team Female categories. Angie will be one of 13 players in the UK Team, along with the only other Scot, Lyndzie Jeffrey from Aberdeen. Master Bailey has been selected as a judge for the championships and is one of 21 International Referees from 19 different European nations. He also becomes the first UK referee to judge at the Europeans.
