Selection Criteria

Scottish National Poomsae Team



The following is the selection criteria for the Scottish National Poomsae Team for 2011.

National Squad Training Sessions

Competitors will be expected to attend a monthly squad training session, which will double up as the BTCB UK Regional Training Session for Scotland. The 3 hour sessions will be open to all BTCB members at Red Belt and above and will be held in Falkirk, Glasgow and Elgin.

The first session will be held at Carronshore Community Centre, Falkirk on Sunday 20th February from 12pm to 3pm.

Selection Points

Competitors will be awarded selection points for attendance at monthly training sessions and for competing at selection events.

Attendance at National Squad Session = 2 points

Selection Events

- * BTCB National Championships – 5th & 6th Feb 2011
- * UTA Milton Keynes Poomsae Championships – May 2011 (TBC)
- * UTA Northern Ireland Championships – June 2011 (TBC)

Points will be awarded for Scottish Team Ranking.

Pairs and Synchron teams are also subject to the selection criteria and must compete for ranking positions.

The top 3 Scottish competitors from each category will receive points:

Top Scottish Competitor = 5 points

2nd Scottish Competitor = 4 points

3rd Scottish Competitor = 3 points

Team Announcement

The team to represent Scotland (possibly at the Korea Open) will be announced at the National Squad Training Session in August 2011. The team will be expected to attend further team training sessions in the lead up to any major championships and to compete at the Scottish Open Poomsae Championships – 8th October 2011.
